

Loxton Golf Club - Greywater Policy

What is Greywater?

Greywater is wastewater generated from:

- Bathrooms, including showers, baths and hand basins
- Laundries, including washing machines and troughs
- Kitchens, including sinks and dishwashers.

As per advice received from The District Council of Loxton Waikerie and in accordance with SA Health Greywater information, The Loxton Golf Club advises users of our facility to adhere to the following:

Visitors Requirements:

- Grey water hoses are not permitted to be placed on the ground
- The Loxton Golf Club does not have facilities to collect or dispose of Greywater.
- Greywater from caravans needs to be collected in a holding tank.
- Greywater is to be disposed of at a local dump point.
- Loxton's dumping station is located at Corner of Pine Ave & AW Traeger Drive.
